Seniors are permitted to leave the H. Frank Carey campus during lunch and/or their free periods, but this senior privilege is **granted only upon your approval**. Please read through the following guidelines with your child, fill out the required information, sign below, and have your child sign as well. Please return this completed form to the main office on or before the first day of school on 9/5/18. If easier, you may email the completed form to mmaniscalco@sewanhaskaschools.org as well.

- It is the parents' responsibility to monitor the student while at their home and/or in the community during free periods.
- Seniors must carry and present their Senior ID Lunch Pass to security and faculty/staff members upon request when leaving the building. If a student does not have his or her pass, he may not leave school grounds.
- Seniors who leave the campus must do so quietly and promptly during the four minutes passing time.
- Seniors may not exit the campus to smoke, vape, loiter or congregate on the surrounding streets.
- Seniors must return to the building for their next assigned class on time. Lateness will not be tolerated. If a senior returns to school early or stays in school, he/she must remain in Dining Hall South.
- Seniors must enter through the **Door 2 when returning** to school.
- This privilege is for *seniors only*. Seniors are not permitted to drive or transport underclassmen off campus during the school day.
- This pass will be issued only to students who academically are in good standing and are enrolled in senior-level classes.
- Seniors may not allow other students to use their Senior Lunch Pass.
