In order to further assist families in determining when additional assistance could be indicated, below are outlined some of the more common situations that bring them to seek outside treatment. Each issue includes a hotline that can serve as a starting point for help; the hospitals, clinics, and private practitioners listed further along in this guide each have specialties listed that will direct you to one that might be appropriate for that concern.

The following categories are meant to guide and inform, and are in no way an exhaustive list of emotional/social/physical issues, nor are they intended to substitute for a qualified clinical assessment and/or diagnosis.

#### Mental Health

General mental health issues encompass a wide array of struggles teens and families may face. Some common – but certainly not the only – terms you may hear include depression and anxiety, of which there are varied forms. Examples of symptoms you may notice of either of these conditions include:

- self-injurious behavior;
- suicide threat or gesture;
- loss of interest in/withdrawal from life activities;
- fear of social/ school situations;
- drastic change in following of typical life routines.

In addition to the clinical services provided by the home school in the district and the hospitals and clinics listed in this referral guide, it can also be helpful to have a resource in a time of crisis. A hotline you may access is:

#### Substance Abuse

Teens may abuse substances – drugs and/or alcohol – for any number of reasons and may do so in concert with mental health issues as well. Abuse of substances may serve as an escape from issues that trouble teens, ones in which they feel there is no hope or that they cannot control. A small sample of indicators that your teen may be involved in substance abuse follows:

- increasingly angry or defiant;
- uncharacteristically isolated and withdrawn;
- secretive concerning behaviors or whereabouts;
- denies, lies, or covers up;
- loses interest in hobbies or activities;
- takes unnecessary risks or acts in a reckless manner

Should you have any concerns regarding a possible substance abuse problem for your child or any family member, referrals to agencies providing specific services geared towards individuals with this issue can be found in this guide. Additionally, a call to the hotline can assist:

#### **Eating Disorders**

Eating disorders commonly occur in young women but can affect young men as well. Disordered eating can occur as a way for people to control something when they feel out of control in other areas of their lives. Eating disorders revolve around two specific areas: restricted eating or overeating. Some disorders you may have heard of include anorexia nervosa (severely restricted eating); bulimia nervosa (binging and then purging through vomiting or excessive exercise); binge eating (eating large and excessive amounts of food in extremely short periods of time). Like substance abuse issues, eating disorders may occur along with mental health struggles. Some possible indicators of an eating disorder include:

- intense fear of gaining weight;
- exhibits a disturbed perception of their shape or size;
- loss of menstruation (in females);
- eating exceptionally large amounts of food in a short time period;
- excessive/ extreme exercise
- hoarding/ hiding food in inappropriate places

#### Bereavement/Grief

Grief and loss is a common area of distress that involves not only bereavement over the death of someone close, but can take varied forms including loss of familiar relationships or situations, e.g. a best friend moves, parents divorce, move to a new neighborhood. If left unaddressed, feelings about any kind of loss can lead to the struggles formerly mentioned – emotional issues, substance abuse, and eating disorders. Indicators of grief can be complicated and varied and are all normal reactions, but nevertheless need attention. Some signs you may notice that a family member is in a bereavement process include:

- sadness, frequent crying/ teary demeanor;
- anger/ isolation/ withdrawal;
- fear that a parent or loved one may die or leave that seems exaggerated;
- loss of interest in relationships or regular life activities.

If you suspect your teen or family member is suffering grief reactions that are interfering with their daily life, in addition to the referrals in this guide, the Long Island Crisis Center hotline is 516-679-111.
