

Review Announcement

The New York State Education Department's Office of Special Education has initiated a Special Education Program and Services Focused Review in the Sewanhaka Central High School District during the 2017-2018 school year. The purpose of this review is to assess the district's compliance with selected federal and state laws and regulations governing the education of students with disabilities.

The review will be conducted by the Special Education Quality Assurance (SEQA) Regional Office. The review process will involve a review of school records of a representative sample of students with disabilities, classroom visitations and surveys. In addition, meetings of the Committee on Special Education will be observed.
