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Dear Junior Class Parents and Students:

On the morning of Saturday, October 15, 2016, an important scholarship qualifying examination, the PSAT/NMSQT, will be given throughout the district. In 2015 the CollegeBoard changed the format of both the PSAT and the SAT. The PSAT is an excellent practice test for the SAT as well as the qualifying exam for the National Merit Scholarship Competition. All Juniors are encouraged to take the exam. Sophomores may benefit from the practice element, but are not eligible for scholarship consideration. **The Sewanhaka Central High School District** is again pleased to offer a PSAT preparation course designed specifically to meet the needs of our college-bound students. It will concentrate on test format, instruction in math, verbal and writing skills as well as current test-taking strategies. Two complete practice exams (a pre-test and a post-test) will be administered. ***The course curriculum has been modified to reflect the changes to the new exam!*** Recently analyzed test-prep data confirms that success in these programs is directly related to attendance – *the more students attend; the better they do.*

The test preparation program described in this letter is recommended for all Juniors and any **Sophomore students who are enrolled in Math 10A**. The preparation course **DOES NOT** include the cost of, or registration for, the actual PSAT exam, which includes a \$20 fee charged by the CollegeBoard. If students are registering for both the PSAT course and the PSAT exam, they must do so with the school's finance clerk at the same time.

The cost for this preparation course is **\$145** per student, which includes all study materials as well as both a pre-test and a post-test analysis. Students must supply their own calculator, highlighter, pens and pencils for the preparation course and for the exam. The courses will be offered with a choice of afternoon or evening sessions.

Two Important Reminders:

1. Each school in the District organizes its own course schedule.
2. Students must register for the PSAT exam on their own.

Registration will be September 12th – 16th only. Return the registration form (enclosed in this mailing) and payment to the finance clerk in the main office of your building.
